I used the same approach outlined in the draft IAG to figure out the number of samples: $10,500 + 3000 \text{ units} = 13,500 \text{ units} \times 5 \text{ sample/unit} = 67,500$
 $\text{samples} + 10\% \text{ QA} = 74,250 \text{ samples} \times \$100/\text{sample} = \$7,425,000$. 3000
common spaces at 5 samples per common space = 15,000 samples + 10% QA =
 $16500 \times \$100 = \$1,650,000$.
then I added $\$7,425,000 + \$1,650,000 = \$9,075,000$. Validation $74,250 \times$
 $\$20 = \$1,485,000$
