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Skyscraper across from site to reopen

NEW YORK — One Liberty Plaza, the skyscraper directly across from the World Trade Center ruins, will be the first in the immediate area to reopen when it does so Monday.

The 53-story building that houses the Nasdaq administration offices, Goldman Sachs and the Bank of Nova Scotia was used in the days following the attacks to support emergency operations.

"We've worked hard to have it open," said Katherine Vyse, spokeswoman for Brookfield Properties Corp., which owns One Liberty Plaza and One World Financial Center.

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
