2. *The nature of the claim:* Personal injury.

3. *The time when, the place where and the manner in which the claim arose:*

BRUCE GREENBERG, from September 11, 2001 and continuing thereafter for 156 hours over five weeks, was employed as a demolition/debris removal worker at the site of the collapse of the World Trade Center (WTC).

During the above mentioned period, BRUCE GREENBERG was misled into believing that was safe to work, and he was not provided with any respiratory equipment. On May 5, 2004, he learned that the illnesses he suffered were as a direct result of his work at said site and time period.

4. *The items of damage or injuries claimed are (do not state dollar amounts)*

- A. Joint and skeleton pain;
- B. Swollen and infected lymph nodes in entire respiratory area;
- C. Shortness of breathe and choking; and
- D. Dry cough.
