This is the Department of Environmental Protection's version of the second paragraph:

The tests examined samples of both air and dust. The air samples from inside the buildings showed no levels of asbestos above ~~4.0 fibers~~. The dust samples showed low levels of asbestos in some samples and the presence of fiberglass in some other dust samples. Asbestos and fiberglass can create a health risk if they become airborne. As indicated above, there were no airborne asbestos fibers detected in the air sampling. While the dust samples were not unexpected, they underscore the importance of proper cleaning of surfaces to minimize exposure.
