Based on the recommendations of infrastructure agencies and utilities, the following areas are ready to be re-occupied:

- The south side of Murray St. and the north side of Park Pl. from Greenwich St. to Broadway.
- The area encompassed by West St. (on the west), Rector St. (on the south), Albany St./Thames St. (on the north) and Broadway (on the east).
- The buildings on the side streets between Church St. and Broadway from Liberty St. to Park Pl. However, we will not open any of the buildings facing Church St. This will include the following addresses:
 - > All buildings with entrances on Broadway, except 1 Liberty Plaza
 - > 10, 12, 22 Cortlandt St
 - > 2, 12, 18, 20 and 26 Vesey St.
 - > 21 Barclay St., 22 Park Pl.

Please let me know by October 15, 2001 if you have any objections to this plan based on air-quality or environmental health issues. As you know, the sooner we can get people back to their homes and businesses, the sooner we will be able to recover from this incident.
