Quality of water to be / is being pumped from the WTC

Update: DDC provided the following results for the analysis of the water being pumped from groundwater wells outside of the slurry wall:

Chloride:	704 ppm	
Nitrate:	<0.1 ppm	
PH:	7.15	
Total Suspended Solids:	4 ppb	Flow: 6 GPM

*NYSDOH Jim Covey and NYSDEC questioned the quality of the water to be / is being pumped out from the basements of the WTC and from the PA tunnel and into the sewers. DEC has indicated that they are willing to take the lead on this issue (plan, protocol and ultimate disposal), but they need NYC to ask for such assistance.
