Site Fence

Update: Walk-through of half the site was completed by FD, PD and DCAS. To be completed tomorrow. They have DEP's concerns / comments on this issue.

Counter-terrorism Taskforce meeting.

Update: This is a meeting of the NY Metropolitan Counter-Terrorism Committee -- Incident Response Sub-Committee.

Chief topics included:

- Discussion on the appropriateness of developing a First Responder Protocol.
- Discussion of draft Executive Order pertaining to Incident Command.
- Request to provide sub-committee lessons learned from WTC response – what worked and what didn't work.

Required follow-up:

- Review attached Executive Order – Comments due by COB on Tuesday 10/23/01.
- Provide sub-committee with lessons learned.

NYPD requests DEP to attend a counter-terrorism task-force meeting on Tuesday at 3:30 PM, Pier 92 conference room. I'll find out the details of the meeting and report back.

ConEd requests sewer and water service for temporary steam plants

BWSO's Connections met with ConEd. Arrangements were made for a 6" wet connection to the 20" on Vesey Street and an 8" connection into the sewer not the sewer stack as was originally proposed by ConEd.

Health and Safety meeting

Quality of water to be / is being pumped from the WTC

Update: Nothing to report.

NYSDOH Jim Covey and NYSDEC questioned the quality of the water to be / is being pumped out from the basements of the WTC and from the PA tunnel and into the sewers. DEC has indicated that they are willing to take the lead on this issue (plan, protocol and ultimate disposal), but they need NYC to ask for such assistance.

Diana / Al / Doug – How do you want me to handle? Please contact me.

EPA requested to vacuum streets as per Mike Gilsenen.

EPA was requested to clean streets and sidewalks in the following areas:

- South End Av, from Albany to Liberty;
- Washington, from Rector St to Cedar St.;

Cedar St., from Washington to Greenwich;
 Fulton, from Broadway to Church;
 Thames, from Broadway to Greenwich.

Dust Control

It was reported that, due to the high winds this morning, dust was a problem. However, the contractors now have the responsibility for dust suppression and as of this afternoon, the dust condition has improved with the addition of contractor resources.

On-site accidents

There have been a number of near misses on the job site. It was requested that all entering the site wear proper PPE.

Personal Monitoring

OSHA had reported that results of personal monitoring that indicated CO levels above 150 ppm and asbestos at >0.01.

Liberty Plaza to reopen

Reopening of Liberty Plaza scheduled for 10/22.

Debris loads

It was reported that trucks have been observed traveling down Murray St without being tarped. DEC reported that they observed the same condition and pulled the ID of two truckers for such violations.

It was also reported that some loads are so hot that they continue to burn in the back of the dump truck. FD considering stationing a pumper mid-way on the SI expressway.
