 Summary of outstanding activities for 10/22/01.

FDNY HazMat has offered to speak to DEP Upstate HazMat regarding response to suspicious package protocol.

Mike: Please let me know if you want to take FDNY up on their offer?

OEM requests assistance in design and installation of storm water runoff from their new HQ.

Update: BWSO to assist.

OEM has requested assistance in design and installation of a storm water management system for their new facility being built in Gravesend, BK (W13 St & Ave Z). Apparently, a large parking lot is being constructed and OEM has asked for assistance in installing catch basins / storm drains. Is this something for DEP or DDC?

Health and Safety meeting

EPA detected low levels of Freon 22 at two locations.

FYI - EPA detected Freon 22 at concentrations up to 48 ppm on the pile at the North Tower and #6 WTC locations.

Quality of water to be / is being pumped from the WTC

Update: EPA requested DEP HazMat to conduct the sampling. M. Fawzy to make arrangements.

Additional sampling and analysis of the water in the basement will be conducted by EPA. Industrial Waste is working with DDC and their contractor on developing a plan. DDC did not identify when dewatering would begin.

NYSDOH Jim Covey and NYSDEC questioned the quality of the water to be / is being pumped out from the basements of the WTC and from the PA tunnel and into the sewers. DEC has indicated that they are willing to take the lead on this issue (plan, protocol and ultimate disposal), but they need NYC to ask for such assistance.

Dust Control

Update: Dust control continues to be problematic despite my efforts in speaking to contractor foremen on site, discussions at the 9:00 AM DDC/Contractor meeting and the 6:00 PM Health and Safety Meeting. I've begun to document dust suppression activities in support of my comments made at the meetings.
