Summary of outstanding activities for 10/31/01.

Site visit - Debris moved by NYC DOT

Update: FBI directed material to be brought to Fresh Kills landfill. No involvement by DEP required.

DOT requests guidance regarding the testing/disposal of debris removed on-site by NYC DOT from the Park within Battery park City to the ball field located at West Street and Chambers Street. About 600 tons of debris from the WTC collapse was moved in order to clear space needed. OEM states that FBI does not need this debris. Please inform of any testing or special method of disposal required.

Health and Safety meeting

Meeting to be combined with DDC Contractor Health and Safety Mtg.

1800 hr Health and Safety meeting to be combined with DDC's 0800 hr contractor health and safety meeting held at Ground Zero (IS89). First combined meeting to be held on Monday, 11/05/01 at IS 89, second floor.

Issues pertaining to Staten Island Landfill will be discussed at the 1100 hr operational meeting held at the FBI trailer at the Landfill every Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Mandatory respirator fit testing to be required for access to pile.

In about three weeks, no one will be permitted on the pile without having gone through respirator fit testing. Beginning this Friday at 1:00 PM, fit testing will be provided on-site. Location to be determined. Fit testing will be open from 1:00 PM to 1:00 AM. Individuals who have already been fit tested will need to present documentation to receive the appropriate sticker that will be affixed to access badge.

New inner perimeter to be established.

In addition to the newly established perimeter, a new inner perimeter around the pile is in the works. Access to this area will require additional credentialing. The exact perimeter and process/policy has not been determined. I'll provide more information as it becomes available.

Today I attended the DDC / FDNY Operational meeting at the WTC. The following issues arose:

NYS DEC stated they are issuing violations to idling trucks at the site and will continue to issue violations.

DDC again reminded their contractors to improve dust suppression. Paul wanted me to mention there will be a meeting regarding dust suppression today at 3 p.m. at Pier 92, which he will attend.

DDC announced that the US EPA will hold a meeting to brief the contractors on environmental issues tomorrow @10 a.m. at 3 World Financial Center, 26th Floor. City agencies are welcome to attend. Please let Paul Bennett know if you plan to have someone attend the meeting.

Subject: Summary of 12/3 Dust Suppression mtg

Mtg: Dust Suppression at WTC site, 12/3/01, 3PM
Attending: DDC, DOH, OEM, DEP
Summary: DOH Assnt Commissioner Kelly McKenny stated that he was not comfortable with opening up additional areas around ground zero unless dust suppression could be improved. DDC indicated that they thought dust suppression was effective. DOH and DEP agreed that the current dust suppression efforts were considerably better now than they were during the early stages of the rescue/recovery efforts. However, DOH reiterated that in order to shrink the red zone further would require even better dust suppression. DOH / DDC also stated that they have not seen any recent air monitoring results for several parameters and would like to get them from DEC and EPA.

The meeting concluded with DDC stating that they will review enhanced dust suppression recommendations made by Bectel (the Health and Safety organization that developed the original Site Health and Safety Plan) and get back to DOH on their findings.

No time was set for a follow-up meeting.
