Ben and I spoke and he took notes at the last 125 Cedar meeting (I wasn't there). Ben reports that we made the following commitments:

- 1) To share a draft SOW with the residents BEFORE its final (DEP will need to do this, so we should ask Mike Gilsenan)
- 2) To test for MERCURY with the Lumex
- 3) To CONSIDER pre and post testing for dioxin
- 4) To CONSIDER followup testing 6 months to a year after the cleanup
- 5) To get NYCDOH to send someone to check on the mold
- 6) Bob commitment to ask asbestos experts to provide a list of various items and how to properly clean them (this would also be fab for the Web page in general!).

I suspect we will be asked to report progress on these commitments before today's meeting. I think we should quickly run through them at the 1:30 pre-meeting.
