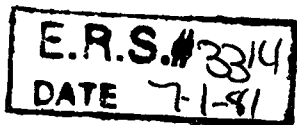
However, we would like to point out that any future submission of projects to this department for review and approval has to allow for a minimum of four weeks for review, processing and the transmittal of our comments.
