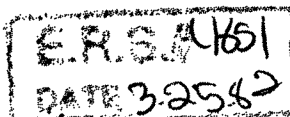
Please inspect the structural conditions (both exterior and interior) of the sewer so as to determine what effect the proposed construction might have on it.
